

QMF Inc Camping Terms and Conditions

This ticket is sold by Queenscliff Music Festival Inc (ABN 16 774 741 067), a not for profit community based organisation responsible for the Queenscliff Music Festival (“the Festival”) and camping on the Queenscliff Reserve Oval (“the Oval”).

IMPORTANT: All the terms and conditions of your Festival ticket shall apply to your camping ticket so please read those conditions in conjunction with this ticket.

Safety and Conduct

1. **NO ALCOHOL.** The Queenscliff Reserve and Oval is an **ALCOHOL FREE ZONE** within the Borough of Queenscliffe Bylaws. Any alcohol consumed in this area WILL cause immediate eviction without refund AND loss of your campground AND Festival wristbands (or cancellation of your tickets if not already wristbanded).
2. **NO GLASS.** The Queenscliff Reserve and Oval is a **GLASS FREE ZONE** and no glass shall be brought into any part of this area. Do not bring glass into the campground: camping, lush green grass and broken glass do NOT MIX. Breach of this condition WILL result in immediate eviction without refund AND loss of your campground AND Festival wristbands (or cancellation of your tickets if not already wristbanded).
3. Strictly **NO COMBUSTIBLES** (eg gas lanterns, fireworks) are permitted and **NO CAMPFIRES, STOVES OR COOKING** of any kind are permitted. Use of any of these items WILL result in immediate eviction without refund AND loss of your campground AND Festival wristbands (or cancellation of your tickets if not already wristbanded).
4. **NO SMOKING** is permitted within the Festival campground. Smoking is only permitted in designated areas away from the tent areas. Breach of this condition WILL result in immediate eviction without refund AND loss of your campground AND Festival wristbands (or cancellation of your tickets if not already wristbanded).
5. **NO NOISE.** The quiet and order of the Festival campground and its neighbourhood will be maintained. Any unruly behaviour will not be tolerated. No parties will be allowed in the camping area. Breach of this condition WILL result in eviction without refund AND loss of your campground AND Festival wristbands. Quiet-time between 10pm and 8am will be enforced.
6. **NO DRUGS.** Anyone found supplying or consuming **ILLICIT DRUGS** will be evicted from the premises without refund AND will lose their campground AND Festival wristbands, and may face criminal charges.
7. These conditions are in force to allow us to continue to offer the cheapest way of staying in Queenscliff. **Abuse it and Lose it is the Mantra !** To ensure the safe operation of the campground and its ongoing availability, we reserve the right to SEARCH ALL Bags and Equipment brought into the campground for GLASS, ALCOHOL and COMBUSTIBLES, STOVES & COOKING EQUIPMENT.

Ticketing

8. Camping tickets are **sold on a per person basis**, not per site. Camping tickets are not transferable. You cannot share your ticket with other people. Camping tickets are exchanged for wristbands which are non-transferable and must be worn at all times for the duration of the Festival.

9. Camping tickets are separate to Festival tickets. You will need two tickets, one to camp and one to gain entry to the Festival.
10. You cannot purchase a Camping ticket without having purchased a Festival Ticket. **You will not be allowed to set up your tent(s) until you produce a valid Festival Ticket for every person (*except children 13 years and under) intending to camp and stay in the tent(s).** * Children 13 years and under are FREE, they do not need a Camping Ticket and they do not need a Festival Ticket.
11. Children under the age of 18 MUST camp with a responsible festival going adult. **Under 18s will only be admitted to the camping site with accompanying responsible ticked adult.** WE WILL and reserve the right to CHECK PHOTO ID to confirm the age of campers.
12. Camping tickets are limited and will not be available for sale in Queenscliff.
13. Queenscliff Music Festival is an all-weather event. No refunds will be made if you are evicted from the campground or Festival, or if you decide not to attend any part of the Festival.
14. Lost or stolen tickets will not be replaced.

Arrival and Entry

15. Each person must have their own photo ID, and Festival Ticket, and Camping Ticket ready to present to QMF Camping staff on arrival at the Reserve.
16. Please arrive and set up before 10pm. You do not have to be there Friday (ie you can come for Saturday night only). Cost remains the same regardless of number of nights you stay. No refunds under any conditions.
17. Space is limited - you will be allocated a 3mx3m patch of grass. Tents must be small and of a reasonable size (i.e. 1-2 man tents only). No "palace" like structures, annexes or annexations of neighbouring sites will be allowed. This is to ensure impact on the Oval is limited and that Cricket can resume straight after the Festival. 18. The camping zone on the Oval will be clearly marked and delineated. Absolutely no access or intrusion onto the wicket area will be allowed or tolerated.
19. You are not able to save spots for friends. If you intend to camp alongside friends you must meet up beforehand and arrive together.
20. No vehicles are allowed into the Camping Reserve.
21. Campers will need to park their vehicles outside the Camping Reserve and then carry camping/personal equipment into the Camping Reserve.
22. Each camping ticket will allow you to camp for 2 nights from 12 noon Fri of the Festival until 8pm Sunday of the Festival. On departure from the campsite please make sure all your belongings and camping equipment are removed.
23. There will be a QMF Camping Manager who will be available for any questions you have, or to help you with other needs. If you have any problems please don't hesitate to contact the manager or security (24hrs) at any time.
24. Security personnel will undertake regular patrols of the camping area.

General

25. Animals are not permitted in the Queenscliff Reserve, Oval or at the Festival, except in accordance with legislation.
26. QMF Inc or the venue shall not be held liable for any loss, theft, injury or damages sustained entering, or on the site. Don't leave valuables in your tent. Lock them out of sight in your car, or even better, do not bring laptops, jewellery or expensive items to the Festival – do you really need them?
27. Please respect the site and your fellow campers. Any unruly behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in your eviction from the site and the Festival without refund. 24 hour security is on hand to ensure the safety and amenity of all campers.
28. No drums are allowed in the camping area. No excessive noise and amplified music after 10pm.
29. Please be respectful and place any litter in the recycle or other bins provided around the camping zone. Be waste and water wise -thank you.
